



Welcome to our Autumn Term in Y4! We have a lot of exciting learning ahead!

Maths We start by exploring shape and position, and then move

on to develop our understanding of place value, including ordering, comparing, rounding numbers and Roman numerals. The four rules of number will be at the heart of our maths



learning with more formal written methods being practised alongside word problems, where we will learn to reason and problem solve. There is a strong focus on times tables up to 12x12, recalling them quickly and using this knowledge to solve problems. Later in Y4, we will be participating in the National

Multiplication Test, so practising your times tables every day is essential please!



English Children will <u>read</u> regularly, and need their book in school every day please. Our writing lessons begin with character descriptions, selecting words carefully. Then we will work on suspense writing,

building tension and effect for the reader, followed by explanation texts, where we work to explain just how things actually work! We will be using a variety of vocabulary, con junctions, fronted adverbials and punctuation to make our writing exciting and engage the reader. We continue to work on spelling, punctuation skills and grammar (SPAG) and apply it in our writing. Children will have spellings to learn weekly and these will be tested each week in school - please continue to help them practise at home and ensure their spelling book is in school each week.



<u>Science</u> As Scientists, the children will be learning about Electricity, including sources. We will construct and explore circuits using components, and learn about conductors. After half term, we move onto our Sound topic.

P.E This term, 13 and 15 PE session are Wed Fri. Class 14 are Wed Thurs. There will be a focus on invasion games, learning about a range of ball skills and team sports, including tactics and working together.

PSHE continues as an important part of our curriculum. As well as focusing on friendships and school rules, we will



also be developing the social and emotional wellbeing of all our children and the value of respect for ourselves and others.

Religious Education. The children will be learning about why God is important to Jewish people, exploring Shabbat and the features of a Jewish synagoque.

Thematic Topic

We have several topics this term! We begin with our '**Lightning Speed** topic, using our **<u>Computing</u>** and Science skills to explore



communication in a digital age. We

will discuss the development of technology through time, researching our own timeline in History, and explore tempo as an important element in Music. We will use our DT skills to create our own designs as an inventor. After half term, we will move onto our "Window on the World" topic, using our Geography skills.

In MFL, we will be learning French vocabulary for family names and parts for the body. The children will then will be taught how to say phrases using con junctions and quanti fiers.

An exciting term ahead we are very much looking forward to our new learning together! 😊
