




Communication & Language and Literacy

Reading

Read the eBook 'Seren's Seasons'. You will find the eBook on twinkl by searching the name of the story 'Seren's Seasons'. Take time to read this story with your child. Look at the pictures together and talk about them.


Key questions to ask your child: *What can you see? What do you think will happen next? How do you think the story will end? What seasons are in the story? What season is it now? What was your favourite part of the story?*



Reading is essential to your child's development. Please read a story every evening before bed with your child.

Phonics

This week, we are learning the phoneme 'd'. What objects can you find around the house that begin with the sound 'd'? Maybe your grown ups can help you learn the formation rhyme 'Around the dinosaurs bottom, up his tall neck and down to his toes'. Can you practice writing the new sound 'd'.



Eye spy

Play a game of eye spy in your kitchen. What can you see?

Example: *I spy with my little eye, something beginning with 'p'.*

Possible answers: *pan/pasta/pizza.*

Spring

Let's make a spring picture!

The weather is getting brighter day by day! Can you go outside to look for signs of spring? What can you see? What is the weather like? Can you see any flowers? Can you see any animals/mini-beasts? Using objects you may find outside or colouring crayons, create a spring picture.



Let's create a spring song!

Can you tap out a beat using pots and pans? Can you sing some words to your beat?

E.g *It is spring time, it is spring time, bees are buzzing, bees are buzzing...*

PSHE

Breakfast time!

Can you make breakfast with your family this week? I wonder if you can pour your own cereal and milk in to the bowl. Can you help spread the butter on your toast? Can you cut the fruit up and pour on your own yoghurt? When breakfast is made, sit together as a family and talk about what you are all going to be doing today. Take turns to speak. E.g, *Today we are going to learn about... Today I would like to play... When we go outside...*



Other Learning Opportunities

- Make a den using sheets, blankets and cushions
- Design your own Easter egg
- Make a castle using recycling
- Make your own puppet using a sock
- Bake with your family
- Make a mud pie in your garden using leaves, soil, sticks
- Put colours/ numbers around the garden- Can you run/hop/skip to the number called?
- Make your own Play-Dough – see separate *Messy Play* document
- Making music –Bottles filled with rice/pasta.
- Traffic light game- red: stop, orange: walk, green: run, speed bumps: jump, roundabout: spin, ice: skid, reverse: walk backwards
- Write you name in shaving foam
