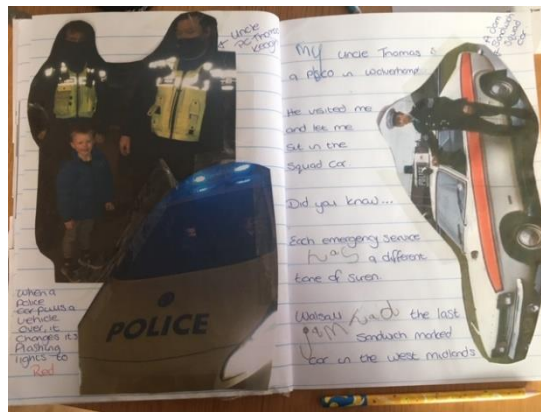


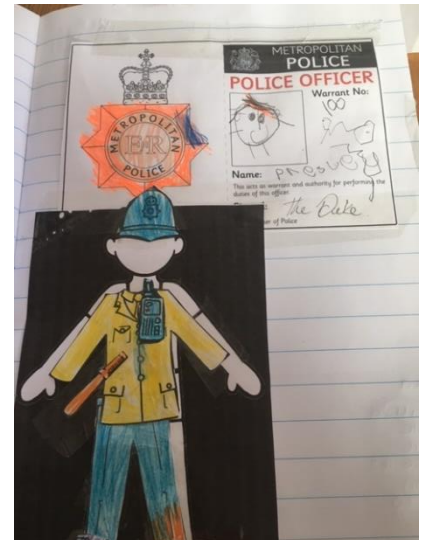
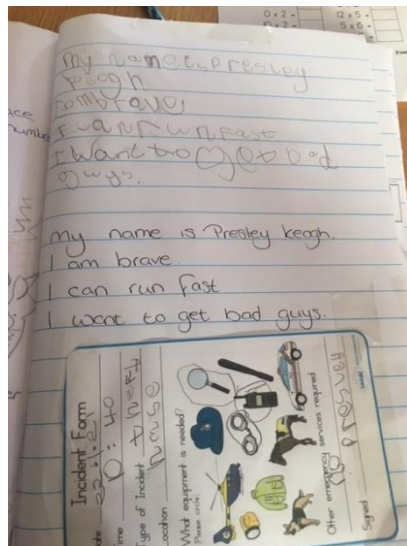
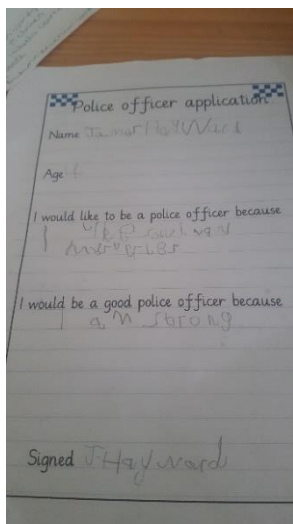
Reception Home Learning – Week 3

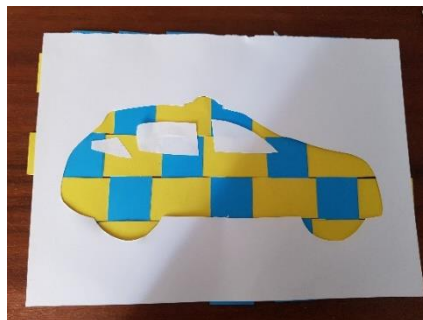
After learning about what the job of a Police Officer entails, children were then encouraged to fill out an application form to apply for a job!
